



GRANT DESCRIPTION AND FUNDED ACTIVITIES	
<p>What is the MI Kid Back on Track Grant?</p> 	<p>The MI Kids Back on Track grant funds (MCL388.1623g) will support programs provided before school, during school, after school, or during the summer. These funds are designed to address unfinished learning, get students to grade-level academic standards, provide additional academic assistance to students at risk of falling behind their peers, or help high school students prepare for postsecondary education.</p> <p>A district-wide improvement plan was prepared in MICIP, which outlines initiatives and strategies to improve student outcomes.</p> <p style="text-align: right;">Total Funds Allotted: \$390,398.00</p>
<p>Individualized Support</p> 	<p>River Rouge School District has established a partnership with Invest in Our Youth Young Achievers Mentorship Programs that will advocate for students at risk and provide effective academic and psychological support and guidance that promotes student success. Trained adult advocates will help students who have fallen off track by providing individualized support to meet their academic, personal, and emotional needs.</p>
<p>Tutoring</p> 	<p>(2) Interventionist will provide additional academic assistance to students at risk of falling behind their peers. They will implement evidence-based interventions to address learning gaps and accelerate learning before or after school, three days each week for up to 3 hours.</p>
<p>Career Pathways</p> 	<p>The River Rouge School District offers dual enrollment as a career pathway to prepare students for college and career opportunities leading them to postsecondary institutions and successful employment. A Dual Enrollment Coordinator will work with college partners, parents, and students to serve as a conduit between the high school and the college faculty. Tuition Cost and Book fee will be paid through the grant to support student academic success.</p>
<p>Data Collector</p> 	<p>Data Collectors conduct data queries, maintain data integrity and security, analyze data in order to improve outcomes, and ensure proper collection of various data for state compliance reporting. This is a mandatory request through the state, which is above and beyond the duties of the employee.</p>
<p>Strategy Implementor</p> 	<p>Strategy Implementor/Program Expert will provide grant oversight and will monitor the implementation of grant activities reporting outcomes to MDE. This is a mandatory request through the state, which is above and beyond the duties of the employee.</p>
